

Monumental Expeditions - The Numbers

Directions to Railroad Bridge State Parks Access Area

GPS : 38.923336 -106.169753

(Simply enter the GPS coordinates into you phones map app, or just Google search it.)

Please arrive 30 minutes prior to trip time.

We meet you at the Railroad Bridge State Parks Access Area.

(Located north of Buena Vista, CO.)

From Johnson Village

- Head west on 24/285.
- At the T-intersection stoplight take a right and continue on 24 to Buena Vista.
- After 2.5 miles at the first stoplight (and only in BV) take a right onto East Main St. (County Road 310).
- After two blocks take a left onto N. Colorado Ave.
- Stay on N. Colorado Ave. as it becomes County Road 371
- Continue for 5.9 miles.
- Railroad Bridge Access Area is on the left.
- Look for our white van with Monumental Expeditions in orange on the side.

From Denver

- Head west on 285 for 123 miles, about 2 hours. To Johnson Village.
- At the T-intersection stoplight take a right and continue on 24 to Buena Vista.
- After 2.5 miles at the first stoplight (and only in BV) take a right onto East Main St. (County Road 310).
- After two blocks take a left onto N. Colorado Ave.
- Stay on N. Colorado Ave. as it becomes County Road 371
- Continue for 5.9 miles.
- Railroad Bridge Access Area is on the left.
- Look for our white van with Monumental Expeditions in orange on the side.

From Colorado Springs

- Head west on US 24 for 90 miles, about an hour and a half. To Johnson Village.
- At the T-intersection stoplight take a right and continue on 24 to Buena Vista.
- After 2.5 miles at the first stoplight (and only in BV) take a right onto East Main St. (County Road 310).
- After two blocks take a left onto N. Colorado Ave.
- Stay on N. Colorado Ave. as it becomes County Road 371
- Continue for 5.9 miles.
- Railroad Bridge Access Area is on the left.
- Look for our white van with Monumental Expeditions in orange on the side.

Monumental Expeditions - The Numbers

From Breckenridge

- Head south on 9 for 22.5 miles, about 30 minutes. To Fairplay.
- At Fairplay take a right and head south on 285 for 36 miles, about 40 minutes. To Johnson Village.
- At the T-intersection stoplight take a right and continue on 24 to Buena Vista.
- After 2.5 miles at the first stoplight (and only in BV) take a right onto East Main St. (County Road 310).
- After two blocks take a left onto N. Colorado Ave.
- Stay on N. Colorado Ave. as it becomes County Road 371
- Continue for 5.9 miles.
- Railroad Bridge Access Area is on the left.
- Look for our white van with Monumental Expeditions in orange on the side.

From Grand Junction

- Take I-70 E to for 135 miles to US 24. Take exit 171.
- Follow US-24 E for 65.7 miles to Buena Vista.
- At the first stoplight (and only in BV) take a left onto East Main St. (County Road 310).
- After two blocks take a left onto N. Colorado Ave.
- Stay on N. Colorado Ave. as it becomes County Road 371
- Continue for 5.9 miles.
- Railroad Bridge Access Area is on the left.
- Look for our white van with Monumental Expeditions in orange on the side.

From Gunnison

- Head east on US 50 over Monarch Pass.
- At Poncha Springs take a left (south) onto Hwy 285 and drive for 24 miles to Buena Vista.
- At the first stoplight (and only in BV) take a right onto East Main St. (County Road 310).
- After two blocks take a left onto N. Colorado Ave.
- Stay on N. Colorado Ave. as it becomes County Road 371
- Continue for 5.9 miles.
- Railroad Bridge Access Area is on the left.
- Look for our white van with Monumental Expeditions in orange on the side.

From Cañon City

- Head west on US 50, for 60 miles to Salida.
- Take a right onto 291 and drive for 10 miles.
- Take a right onto 285 and drive 16.6 miles to Buena Vista.
- At the first stoplight (and only in BV) take a right onto East Main St. (County Road 310).
- After two blocks take a left onto N. Colorado Ave.
- Stay on N. Colorado Ave. as it becomes County Road 371
- Continue for 5.9 miles.
